Our Learning

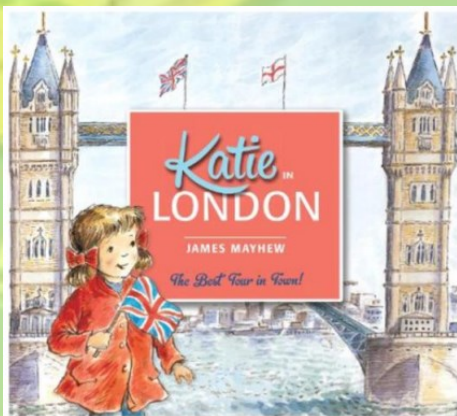
We begin this half term with a mini topic all about ourselves and then our learning will have a Geography focus as we find out about our local area and where we live in relation to the rest of the UK.

Geography-

In Geography we will begin by refreshing our memory by recapping the seven continents of the world before we focus specifically on the UK. We will learn the names of the countries and capital cities of the UK as well as the national flags and some of the human and physical features of the countries. We will finish this unit by looking at differences between cities, towns and villages before studying our local area.

English—

Our English work this half term will centre around the book 'Katie in London' by James Mayhew. We will be reading the book together and learning about some of the famous landmarks in London. We will also be developing our understanding of sentences and how they are structured before writing our own non-chronological reports about London.



Maths -

Our Maths work this half term will begin with a unit on Place Value before beginning our work on Addition and Subtraction.

Year 1 children will be developing their number confidence by writing, comparing and ordering numbers up to 20. They will also be learning to use the related vocabulary of place value and addition and subtraction.

Year 2 children will be taught to count, read, write and order and compare numbers up to 100. They will also be learning about the value of digits in 2-digit numbers and will begin using this knowledge to learn and develop strategies for adding and subtracting num-



Art -

In Art we will be looking at some famous portraits, like Mona Lisa by Leonardo Da Vinci.

We will be drawing our own family and self-portraits, looking closely at the shapes, lines and colours of our faces and features.
