



Dear Parents

Yesterday in assembly, we launched the annual Summer Reading Challenge.

The Summer Reading Challenge is about encouraging children to continue reading and enjoying books through the school holiday. Taking part in the Summer Reading Challenge and reading during the summer will help them when they return to school or start school for the first time.

Children who have signed up for the Summer Reading Challenge and visit a library will be given a collector pack and a sticker for each book they have read. When we say 'read' that includes listening to an audiobook, being read to, using a fact book to learn a new skill or reading a comic.

Children who read 6 books or more and log their reads at the library or online will be able to collect a medal and certificate from their local library. We would love to see lots of the children bringing in their medals and certificates when they return in September.

As a school we also have access to a fantastic range of e-books and audio books via a reading app called Sora. This is free for all children of Curdridge to access. It can either be accessed via your desktop or by downloading the Sora app. Each child has been issued their log in code and this is made up of the year they started school, followed by their first initial with a capital letter and their surname which also needs a capital letter.

For example, from September 2025, Year 6 children will login as 19JBloggs or 19HSmith. Please find below the year you need to enter. The years are based on their year group for September.

Year 6: 19JBloggs	Year 3: 22JBloggs	Year R: 25JBloggs
Year 5: 20JBloggs	Year 2: 23JBloggs	
Year 4: 21JBloggs	Year 1: 24JBloggs
