The Super Sunny Murder Club

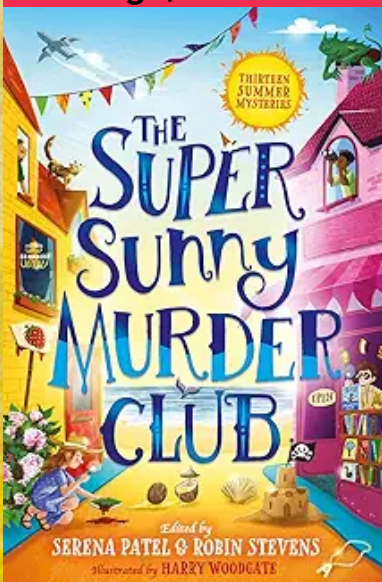
