Dear parents,

Thank you for choosing Curdridge Primary School for your child; we are delighted that you and your child will be joining the school in the autumn. This letter is to give you information about what happens next.

Firstly, if you haven't already done this, you will need to provide us with proof of your child's date of birth (either a birth certificate or passport) and also 2 examples of proof of **your** name and address (this could be a utility bill; council tax bill, bank statement etc.) We are happy for you to scan or photograph these documents and email them to admin@curdridge.hants.sch.uk or you may prefer to come into school during the school day with the documents (which we can then photocopy). This information is needed by **Thursday 30th April** to secure your child's place.

On **Tuesday 9th June @ 6pm** we will be holding a meeting in school for parents. During the meeting we will be sharing with you the arrangements for your child starting school; this will include transition opportunities; organisation of home visits and how to prepare your child for September.

Below are listed two dates when you can visit the school with your child for a 'Make and Do' fun session which will also involve craft and book time. We would love to see as many of you as possible and these sessions are open to the parent, grandparent or childminder looking after your child that afternoon; younger siblings are welcome to join us too.

- **Thursday 11th June 2.15-3.00pm**
- **Thursday 18th June 2.15-3.00pm**

Two unaccompanied visits will also be offered for your child to visit school. These will be:

- **Tuesday 23rd June 1.30pm – 3.00pm**
- **Tuesday 30th June 1.30pm – 3.00pm**

During these visits your child will meet the children who are currently in Class 1 and will take a tour of the school. They will then have time to explore and play in the classroom and outdoor area before you collect them at 3.00pm.

During the course of the transition process, we hope to have the opportunity to discuss with you the individual arrangements for your child starting school and to plan the 'Home Visit' for the beginning of September.

In the meantime, please remember if you have any questions, please phone the school office or visit the school website as we continue to upload information for you.
