Our Learning

During this project, the children will be looking at the physical and human geography of our local area. They will conduct surveys and fieldwork to then create a brochure about Curdridge and the local area.

Geography:

The children will start by locating where Curdridge is in relation to the UK, then Hampshire and then finally where our school is in Curdridge. They will look at a range of maps to identify this and then help them with their field work.

They will then walk the local area looking at the industry, businesses, residential properties and land use. They will also survey local residents to gain their opinion on the local area.

After the field work, the children will look closely at the following:

- Economic activity
- Land use
- Settlements
- Climate zones
- Rivers
- Upland and lowland areas

When they have conducted their studies, they will create a brochure persuading people to visit /live/work in this area.

Maths

During their fieldwork the children will survey residents and identify the numbers of residential properties and industry in the area. They will need to use tallying and then create graphs to show their results.



You also need to conduct a questionnaire with residents in your street.

Question you could ask are:

How long have you lived here?

Are you working/retired/family responsibilities ?

What do you like about the area?

What would you recommend to someone moving into the area?

What would you like to change?

The questions you ask need to find out what is good about the area and what makes it a good place to live.

You need to collate your results for each question for the people you ask. Remember to be polite and you are representing the school.
