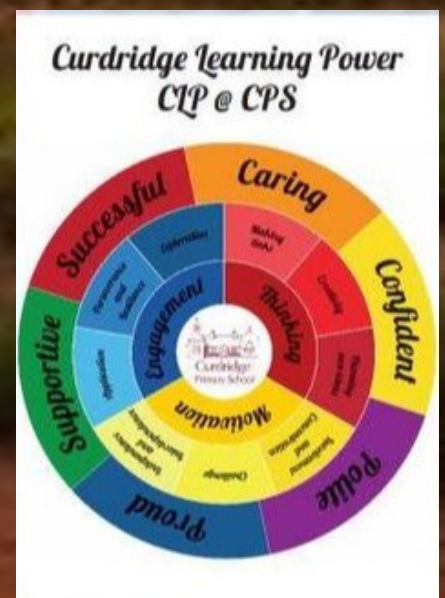

Let's go on Safari

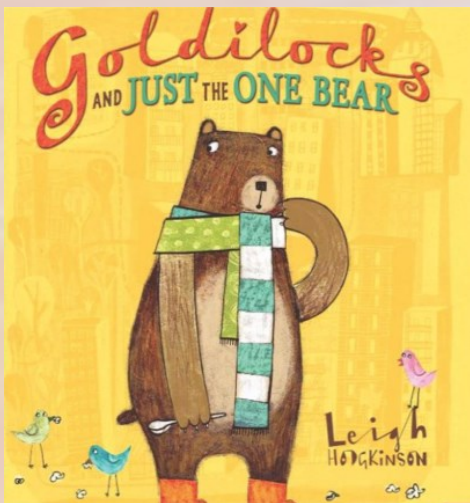


Our Learning

The highlight of this topic is our trip to Marwell on Tuesday 16th June 2026.



We will be learning about the animals we see during our visit and the places in the world they call home, building upon the work we have completed about habitats. We will also be going on an expedition, led by a member of the Marwell Education Team, to support our Science work this half term.



Our English work will be based on the book 'Goldilocks and Just the One Bear' by Leigh Hodgkinson, which uses a familiar traditional story structure to tell a story in a different setting. Children will be exploring new vocabulary before writing their own stories.

Science

Following our trip to Marwell, we will continue to learn about different animals from around the world. We will be classifying and grouping animals using scientific terms such as; 'mammal', 'amphibian', 'herbivore', 'carnivore' and 'omnivore'. We will also be looking closely at the structure of animals and naming and comparing their body parts.



DT

In DT we will be exploring wheels and axles and the differences between fixed and moving parts. We will be learning new vocabulary as we investigate how these parts work using construction resources.



We will be looking at pictures of different safari jeeps, before designing and making our own!
