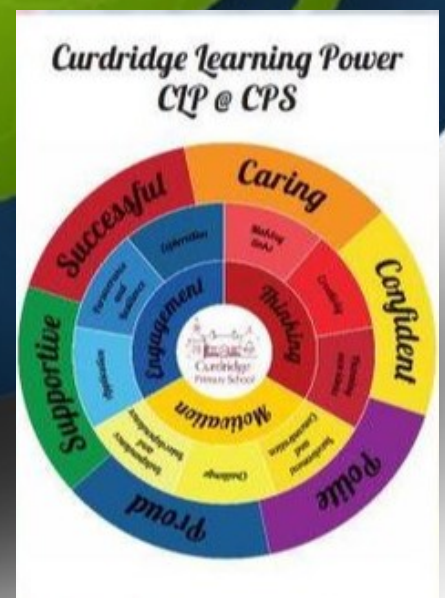


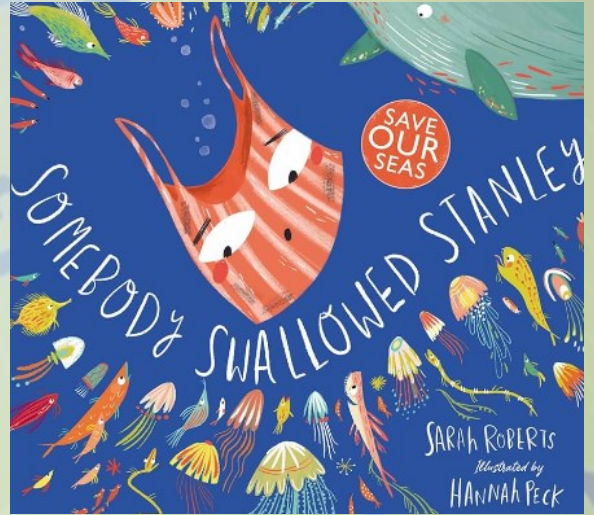
# Year 1 & 2

## Our Learning

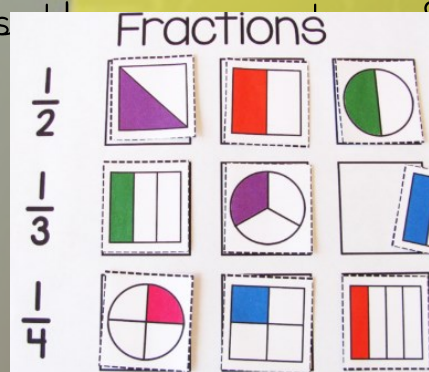
